



## **INTERNATIONALISATION OF LINK CAMPUS UNIVERSITY**

Link Campus University (LCU) with its international vocation has been working with a number of key University International Partners globally.

During 2017 LCU has engaged directly with the London School of Economics (LSE), the University of Stirling, UMA and Lomonosov Moscow State University amongst others.

### **LONDON SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS (LSE) – LCU PROGRAMME.**

THE LONDON SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS (<http://www.lse.ac.uk>) (RANKED SECOND IN THE WORLD AND THE TOP UNIVERSITY IN LONDON) is engaged with a number of activities ranging from a focus on Brexit to specific training programmes and tailor-made modules for students, staff and researchers currently at LINK CAMPUS UNIVERSITY.

LSE has produced many notable alumni in the fields of law, history, economics, philosophy, business, literature, media and politics. Alumni and staff include 52 past or present heads of state or government and 20 members of the current British House of Commons. To 2016, 27% (or 13 out of 48) of all the Nobel Prizes in Economics have been awarded or jointly awarded to LSE alumni, current staff or former staff, making up 17% (13 out of 78) of all laureates. LSE alumni and staff have also won 3 Nobel Peace Prizes, and 2 Nobel Prizes in Literature

All students enrolled at LCU can actively participate in programmes which are organised every year in London – **students at undergraduate, postgraduate and professional courses are entitled to have the LSE EXPERIENCE which is unique to students in ITALY and is offered by Link Campus in conjunction with LSE ENTERPRISE.**

**Academics and Experts of LSE will also visit and participate in the teaching of Link Campus from 2017/18.**

## LOMONOSOV MOSCOW STATE UNIVERSITY AND LINK CAMPUS UNIVERSITY

- Moscow State University was established in 1755 (<https://www.msu.ru/en/>)
- More than 40 000 students (graduate and postgraduate) and about 7.000 undergraduates study at the university, and over 5.000 specialists do the refresher course here. More than 6.000 professors and lecturers, and about 5 000 researchers work for the faculties and research institutes.
- Every year Moscow University enrolls about 4 000 international students and postgraduates from all over the world.
- MSU library system is one of the largest in Russia, with its 9,000,000 books, 2,000,000 of them in foreign languages, and the average number of readers 55,000, using 5,500,000 books a year.

During 2017 Moscow State University and LINK Campus University set up a Lomonosov Centre at Link Campus in Rome, with the support of the two Governments, with the aim of fostering a better understanding of Italian-Mediterranean-Russian relations. Link caters for a centre which provides tuition in Russian Language and also **offers places for Link Campus students to study/conduct research in Russian within the Faculty of Globalistics, MSU.** In summer 2017, Russian Students of Moscow State University attended the Link Campus Summer school focusing on international relations. Link Campus will participate in September at the annual Globalistics Conference in Moscow.
