CALL FOR APPLICATIONS A. Y. 2020/2021

Università degli Studi "Link Campus University" (LCU) has entered into bilateral Agreements with foreign Universities to receive ERAMUS grants in the Erasmus Plus Programme.

We inform students enrolled in LCU who want to take part to the Erasmus+ mobility for studies during a.y. 2020 -2021 that application documents are available as of today.

Erasmus+ grants allocation will depend on EU funding assigned to the University by National Agency Erasmus+ Indire.

Agreements for the Universities highlighted in yellow have not been concluded at the time of the publication as specified by the wording "agreement to be confirmed". Allocation of the grants is conditional upon the completition of the formalisation procedure.

Eligibility requirements

In order to submit an application students of the Università degli studi "Link Campus University" must be enrolled, even "fuori corso", in an undergraduate, graduate or single cycle degree programme, a PHD run by LCU.

N.B.: At the beginning of the mobility period students must be enrolled in an undergraduate, graduate or single cycle degree programme and in case of undergraduate or single cycle degree programme, students must be enrolled in at least second year.

Application for students graduating during the summer and autumn graduation sessions 2019/2020. Mobility will be granted provided that students will be enrolled in programme run by LCU in the academic year 2020/2021.





ERASMUS+

N.B.: Students with citizenship of one of the Countries taking part to the Erasmus+ Programme, are eligible for the mobility to a University in their country of origin but thet will not be prioritised during the selection procedure. In addition they are required to obtain before the mobility the authorization from the host University.

Student with non EU citizenship must comply with the host country rules on visas and resident permits for study purposes.
